

CONDITIONS OF LICENSE

1. The Licence and any certificate of renewal in force shall be kept on the approved premises and shall be produced at the request of an Inspector appointed under Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940.
2. If the licensee wishes to undertake during the currency of the licence the manufacture of any drug specified in Schedule C, C (I) (excluding those specified in Schedule X) not include above, he should apply to the Licensing Authority for the necessary endorsement as provided in Rule 75(3). This Licence will be deemed to extend to the items so endorsed.
3. Any change in the (competent technical staff) shall be forthwith reported to the Licensing Authority.
4. The licensee shall inform the Licensing Authority in writing in the event of any change in the constitutions of the firm operating under the license. Where any change in the constitutions of the firms take place, the current Licence shall be deemed to be valid for a maximum period of three months from the date on which the change takes place unless, in the meantime, a fresh Licence has been taken from the Licensing Authority in the name of the firm with the changed constitution.
